WBR Parish Mask Requirements and Guidelines

In lieu of the governor's press release in regards to the lifting of the mask mandate in Louisiana and returning authority to local governments and businesses, West Baton Rouge Parish has updated its own guidelines.

Effective Immediately, West Baton Rouge Parish **will lift the** mask mandate within the unincorporated areas of the parish **not** specifically mandated by the Governor of Louisiana. WBR citizens should understand private businesses have the right to impose mask mandates within their facilities, if they so choose.

In regards to our parish community centers, capacity will be increased to 75% with social distancing and no masks required.

We ask that the public remains vigilant and continues safe practices and consider CDC's recommendation in regards to vaccinations when making their personal decisions.
